### Present

<b>I</b>	ring
<b>you</b>	ring
<b>he/she/it</b>	rings
<b>we</b>	ring
<b>you</b>	ring
<b>they</b>	ring

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	rang
<b>you</b>	rang
<b>he/she/it</b>	rang
<b>we</b>	rang
<b>you</b>	rang
<b>they</b>	rang

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have rung
<b>you</b>	have rung
<b>he/she/it</b>	has rung
<b>we</b>	have rung
<b>you</b>	have rung
<b>they</b>	have rung

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had rung
<b>you</b>	had rung
<b>he/she/it</b>	had rung
<b>we</b>	had rung
<b>you</b>	had rung
<b>they</b>	had rung

### Future

<b>I</b>	will ring
<b>you</b>	will ring
<b>he/she/it</b>	will ring
<b>we</b>	will ring

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have rung
<b>you</b>	will have rung
<b>he/she/it</b>	will have rung
<b>we</b>	will have rung

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am ringing
<b>you</b>	are ringing
<b>he/she/it</b>	is ringing
<b>we</b>	are ringing
<b>you</b>	are ringing
<b>they</b>	are ringing

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was ringing
<b>you</b>	were ringing
<b>he/she/it</b>	was ringing
<b>we</b>	were ringing
<b>you</b>	were ringing
<b>they</b>	were ringing

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been ringing
<b>you</b>	have been ringing
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been ringing
<b>we</b>	have been ringing
<b>you</b>	have been ringing
<b>they</b>	have been ringing

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been ringing
<b>you</b>	had been ringing
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been ringing
<b>we</b>	had been ringing
<b>you</b>	had been ringing
<b>they</b>	had been ringing

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be ringing
<b>you</b>	will be ringing
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be ringing
